Vineyard

Cultivated in the area mainly corresponding to the hilly region of Roero, rich in sand, with a southeast exposure

Grape Variety

Red grapes

Production

Rosé wines are produced from black grape berries by reducing maceration times in contact with the skins and seeds, ensuring that only a small fraction of coloring substances and tannins are transferred to the wine

Characteristics

It has a pale red color with cherry reflections, a lively, fresh aroma with captivating and persistent fruity notes. Characterized by a lively, nervous, fresh, and pleasant taste, its body and acidity support the gustatory persistence, concluding with savory aftertastes

Pairings

Enhances simple appetizers and pairs perfectly with buttered bread, salmon, and fresh cheeses
